ANSWERS

- a** Give **one** word to describe Chen's tone of voice at the **start** of the speech. Give **one** word or phrase from the text that shows this tone. 2 marks

Possible words to describe Chen's tone include:

- friendly
- enthusiastic
- excited

Possible words or phrases from the text include:

- 'Hey guys'
- 'I look forward to meeting the rest of you and hanging out with you all'
- 'you are going to have a fantastic time!'
- 'fun stuff'
- 'you'll see why we are called Camp Fantastic!'
- 'exciting activities'

- b** Give a reason why Chen's tone of voice changes at the **end** of the speech. 1 mark

Chen becomes serious when discussing safety issues.

- c** Name **one** evening activity available at the camp. 1 mark

Possible answers:

- beach walks
- quiz nights
- dances
- performance nights

- d** Fill in the gaps in the following sentence from the speech. 2 marks

- e** What does Chen mean when she says the area behind the lake is 'out of bounds'? 1 mark

- f** Chen gives two consequences that will occur if someone is found in the area behind the lake. Identify **one** of these consequences. 1 mark

Possible answers include:

- they will be sent home
- they will be banned from returning to Camp Fantastic

- g** Identify **two** of the three main Camp Fantastic rules. 2 marks

Possible answers include:

- The area behind the lake is out of bounds.
- Everyone must go to the emergency meeting place / the oval if they hear the siren.
- Everyone must respect everyone else.
